THE ROLE AND WHAT TO EXPECT

- Monitor, inspect and verify the correct operation of plant, equipment and instrumentation within area of responsibility.
- Maintain, troubleshoot and calibrate plant, equipment and instrumentation within area of responsibility.
- Manage and control in a timely manner the execution of scheduled, planned and unplanned work orders for area of responsibility.
- Identify and create corrective work maintenance notifications for plant, equipment and instrumentation as required.
- Liaise directly with the relevant CLIENT Team Leader / Senior Operator and the adi Site Maintenance Manager - to agree the schedule and priority of work.
- Identify maintenance and/or engineering solutions and implement as requested.
- Continuously review PPM requirements and identify areas for improvement as required.

- Record all relevant information on the CMMS system when completing works.
- Ensure all of the required paperwork is present when works are signed off as complete.
